Maxine Moreau serves as President of CenturyLink's Consumer Markets division. In this role, she has overall P&L responsibility for CenturyLink's Consumer division and all aspects of the company's Consumer strategy, go-to-market and customer experience. Prior to leading Global Operations, Maxine held several leadership roles at CenturyLink, since rejoining the company in 2003. During this period, she led the successful integration of CenturyTel, Embarq, Qwest and Savvis, creating a Fortune 150 company and the third-largest telecommunications provider in the United States.
