Washu (Concept) Canadian Premier

- The Washu-“Eagle’s Wing in Japanese”-showcases Mazda’s innovative approach to how people interact with a vehicle’s interior space
- At the heart of the Washu is a 3.5 liter V6 mated to a six speed transmission with steering-wheel-mounted shift actuators, add in it’s sleek, low and well proportioned exterior design and the barriers that separate sports cars and family cars crumble
- Airline inspired sliding doors that allow rear passengers to enter the vehicle virtually in an upright posture and front doors that open to almost 90 degrees, mean getting in and out is significantly easier than traditional cars or minivans
- Once inside you are surrounded by innovations like the deployable instrument panel with sports and cruise positioning, steer-by-wire technology (eliminating steering shaft), and auto adjustable pedals and throughout, a balance of texture and interior elements that add to the overall sense of interior structure
