

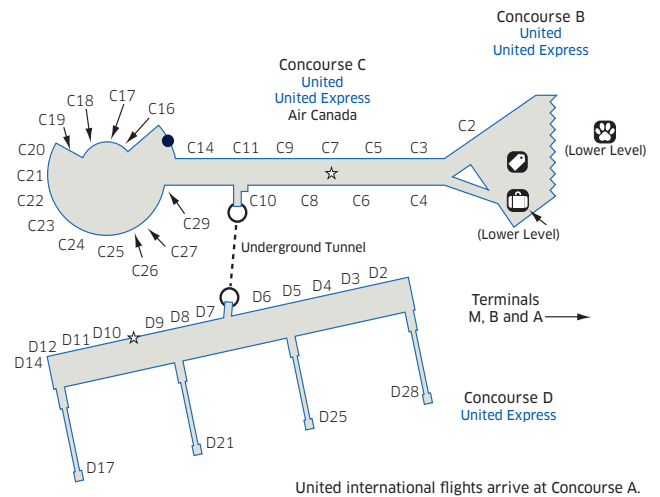

# Cleveland Hopkins International Airport

Cleveland Hopkins International Airport (CLE) was the first municipal airport in the United States. It has provided aviation leadership and serves as a catalyst for economic growth in Cleveland and throughout Northeast Ohio. CLE is Ohio's busiest airport, serving more than 11 million passengers annually. It is positioned within 500 miles of 43 percent of the U.S. population. And for Northeast Ohio travelers, the airport is close – just 12 miles from downtown Cleveland. Travelers also have the option to take the rail to CLE, a connection that, when added in 1968, was another first in the country.

United operates more than 150 daily flights to 62 airports across the United States from CLE, including frequent daily service to top business travel markets in New York, Chicago and Houston.
