- UTI opened its approximately 100,000 square foot, state-of-industry campus in the Miami suburb of Miramar in August of 2022.
- The Miramar campus is one of two campuses in Florida.
- The campus has nine classrooms, six classroom/labs and seven individual labs that supports its automotive, diesel and welding programs.
- Early employment partners include Lithia Motors, Penske Automotive Group, and Florida Detroit Diesel-Allison.

Core Programs

- [Automotive Technology program](#) – The program teaches students how to diagnose, maintain and repair domestic and foreign automobiles.
- [Diesel Technology program](#) – The program teaches students the basic knowledge and skills to diagnose malfunctions in mechanical and electrical systems, and make necessary repairs and replacements on diesel engines, commercial vehicles, and heavy equipment.
- Automotive and Diesel Technology program – The combined program provides students with every Automotive and Diesel course, providing graduates the flexibility to pursue careers in both industries.
- [Welding Technology program](#) – The program gives the hands-on training needed to prepare for a flexible career in industries from automotive fabrication to aerospace. Students learn about the procedures and equipment required to weld using gas metal arc (GMAW), shielded metal arc (SMAW), flux-cored arc (FCAW) and gas tungsten arc (GTAW) welders.
