

Kellogg Company Corporate Political Expenditures for 2023 (Jan – June)

Kellogg Company did not contribute to any candidates, political parties, political committees, or ballot initiatives. The company also did not make any independent expenditure contributions to super PACs, 527 organizations, or 501(c)(4) organizations.
