

Kellanova Corporate Political Expenditures for 2023

(Note: On October 2, 2023, Kellogg Company completed the separation of its North American cereal business through a spin-off of WK Kellogg Co and changed its name to Kellanova. Political activities prior to October 2023 were conducted under the Kellogg Company name and are included in the archives.)

Kellanova did not contribute to any candidates, political parties, political committees, or ballot initiatives. The company also did not make any independent expenditure contributions to super PACs, 527 organizations, or 501(c)(4) organizations.

Some of our trade associations utilized a portion of our dues to engage in their own lobbying activities. Below is a list of trade associations and/or 501(c)(4) groups to which Kellanova's dues/payments were \geq \$50,000 in 2023, and the amount used for political activities (as reported to us by the organization).
