- Cox offers more than 3,500 CoxWiFi hotspots in Virginia, CT, Omaha, Phoenix, Las Vegas, San Diego and Tucson with a roadmap to add more across Cox markets this year, including Rhode Island this summer.
- Cox customers now have access to the nation's largest WiFi network of more than 300,000 hotspots made possible by a collaboration of cable companies across the country, called CableWiFi launched in 2013.
- CoxWiFi and CableWiFi are free for Cox customers with Preferred, Premiere, Ultimate or G1GABLAST service.
- The hotspots are strategically located in high-traffic areas such as restaurants, malls, sports arenas, parks and beaches in cities like NYC, Washington D.C., Boston, Richmond, Philadelphia, Los Angeles and Tampa.
- Cox subscribers who have authenticated their device on a CableWiFi hot spot will be able to have the same device automatically connect to the CableWiFi SSID as long as they remain a Cox High Speed Internet customer.
- Mobile subscribers will have the added benefit of using the WiFi network when outside the home or business, reducing their dependence on mobile data plans. Additionally, CoxWiFi provides some of the fastest out-of-home WiFi speeds and is faster than the average home broadband speeds across the U.S.
