In 2021, 44.4% of management roles globally were filled by women. In 2021, 22.2% of management roles in the US were filled by underrepresented talent.
People	Engage 1.5 billion people in advocating for sustainable and equitable access to food by the end of 2030.	Since 2015, Kellogg employees have volunteered over 106,000 hours in our communities around the world.
