Maxwell Moldovan, of Uniontown, Ohio (3-over 74)

(on his round today)

“It wasn’t the best day. I thought I managed pretty well. I didn’t hit it very well. Hit my tee shots pretty good, irons were shaky, and hit a lot of good putts but not a lot went in.

(on being able to pick up where he left off following a win at the Ohio Amateur)

“Yeah, I was hoping I could do that, but I think this course is a little more challenging than Moraine Country Club, which I just played. I think with the format here, you don’t have to take it super low the first two days. You just need to get yourself into match play, and then in match play, I feel like it doesn’t really matter who you play, anything can happen.”

(on the course difficulty and how it suits his game)

“I think it suits my game pretty well because this is a course obviously you need to hit fairways with how thick this rough is, and I usually do a pretty good job of that. It’s definitely really difficult though. The green complexes and how fast they are. It’s definitely a good challenge.”

(on aftermath of his Ohio Amateur win last week)

“It’s been a lot the last few days. Traveling and talking to a lot of people. Going from there, one day off, and then coming here. It’s definitely a real blessing to win the Ohio Am, it’s something that I’ve wanted to do the last few years. To put my name on a trophy with Arnold Palmer, Jason Kokrak, Ben Curtis and some other names is really, really cool.”
