Brett Roberts, of Coral Springs, Fla. (1-under 70)

(thoughts on his round)

“It was kind of an up-and-down round. I got off to a bad start, 2-over through two, but I felt confident in how I was playing and rolling the ball, and I made some birdies in the middle of the round. Got it to 3-under at one point, and then struggled a little bit coming in.”

(on his streak of five birdies in six holes [#8-13])

“There wasn’t a lot of wind, so I knew I could be a little aggressive. That stretch of holes, there’s a lot of wedges you have in, so I kind of attacked the pins and had a couple tap-in birdies.”

(on the effect of the weather delays)

“If anything, it helped me mentally, gathering myself. We had one delay, then I birdied 8. And then we had a delay on 9. Then I came out and birdied 9 and 10.”

(on mindset going into tomorrow)

“Just trying to do the same as I did today and make as many birdies as I can. Hopefully a lot of pars too. Stay around even par.”

(initial thoughts on the course)

“It was tricky. If you missed the greens in some tough places, it was very hard to get it up-and-down. Like on 18 if you missed right, there’s almost no shot at getting it up-and-down.”
