William Moll, of Houston, Texas (70-68--138)

(on the prospect of being medalist)

"It would be super cool to be on top of this great field. I put myself in a good position for match play so I am looking forward to that and hopefully I can get it done there."

(where would medalist honor rank)

"Probably on top of my career because there are very few USGA events and they are really big deals. Being the top golfer in stroke play would be super awesome and a dream come true."

(on his good play)

"I have been hitting it really good recently. On this course that is the key. You have put yourself on fairways and greens. Get yourself in position. My putter also got hot. Just staying focused matters because every shot matters on this course."

Notes

(double bogey)

18 – found left bunker in fairway, 80-yard approach plugged in front bunker, rolled through green into another greenside bunker and two-putted

(birdies on inward nine came after weather delay)

3 – breaking 30-foot birdie putt

7 – 3-wood off tee, 7-iron approach from 189 yards, 11-foot birdie putt

8 – found fairway bunker off tee, hit 3-wood second shot on par 5 into right greenside bunker, up and down from bunker when he holed 6-foot birdie putt
