## **Q. Not quite as low as yesterday, but still in at 7 under?**

Scott Harvey: “Today was an adventure. I was not near as sharp today. I got off to a good start. Made like a 40-footer on the first hole. I had a couple three-putts. A couple of really good up-and-down pars.”

## **Q. Was it a matter of trying to follow up a really low score with another one?**

Scott Harvey: “My body just didn’t feel like I could move today. I’m exhausted. I’m glad I am done...I get to go watch [NFL] football, relax and hydrate. I’m happy to have the whole afternoon to just chill out and relax.”

## **Q. Was trying to become a five-time U.S. Mid-Am medalist on your mind at all today?**

Scott Harvey: “I definitely would want that, and when I started, I was like, ‘Okay, here we go again.’ But I just didn’t have it today. I wasn’t sharp.”

## **Q. Everyone starts at Ground Zero on Monday. Obviously, you have plenty of match-play experience to draw on?**

Scott Harvey: “I’ve been around it. These [USGA match-play championships], it’s cool if you win [medalist], but it’s OK if you don’t. It doesn’t really matter [where you’re seeded].”

## **Q. And you had the great round at Kinloch. Is there a comfort zone with that layout?**

Scott Harvey: “I was just feeling it [on Saturday]. I don’t know. It definitely fits my eye. There’s only a couple of shots that don’t. I played there about 10 years ago in this CGA (Carolinas Golf Association match against the Virginia State Golf Association) thing. The team matches against Virginia. I love the feel of it. I like the feel of [Independence Golf Club] too.”

## **Q. Do you prefer playing on bentgrass (Kinloch) over bermudagrass (Independence)?**

Scott Harvey: “I like bent greens and bermuda[grass] fairways. But they won’t switch them for me...Kinloch is beautiful. It’s hard not to be in a happy place out there. Everything about it. The hospitality, the golf course, the scenery and the weather is perfect.”
