## **Q. Looks like Daniel gave you quite a tussle today?**

Scott Harvey: “Yeah. He’s a good player and hit it a long way. I got off to a good start, thankfully. He was a little off and you can tell he got a feel for it. But it was a good battle.”

## **Q. Do you like to be tested in that first match?**

Scott Harvey: “The mindset for sure. I like having to stay focused and not get lost because it’s easy to get out of your rhythm, and who knows if you are going to find it again. It made me re-focus that quite a bit. And I needed that.”

## **Q. Was there a key moment in the match?**

Scott Harvey: “On 16, I hit it on the back of the green, which is an almost impossible two-putt. He lipped out his par putt, so I had a 6-footer straight up the hill [to win the hole], and I played it a ball out and it just didn’t break. I had the opportunity to go 2 up with two to go. Hit a good putt, it just didn’t go in. On the last hole (No. 17), I hit it to 2 feet from 129 yards with a gap wedge. At that point, he needed to make birdie or go home. He hit a good shot, and he just didn’t make birdie.”

## **Q. How are you feeling physically?**

Scott Harvey: “For me, my game is fine. It’s more about my body. Speaking of that, I am going to fill it up with something and try to refuel for tomorrow...I felt OK [today]. I overdosed on Ibuprofen yesterday, but I am doing OK.”

**Note** – Harvey won this title in 2014 and was the runner-up in 2016...Now owns a 25-12 record in match play.
