Q. What did hit on your third shot to par-5 18th?

Scott Harvey: "I had 162. I hit an 8-iron, just really good."

Q. How about the birdie on No. 17?

Scott Harvey: "Hit it really close on 17, 139 (yards) with pitching wedge, pitching to about 5 feet. And then I did pull my drive a little bit here [on 18], so I had to lay up. And it's a pretty strategic 18th hole. And he (Foley) hit a bad shot, obviously. And you know, then I hit a good shot."

Q. You are back in the quarterfinals again?

Scott Harvey: "I just got a rest. That's all it is. I have to take ibuprofen and Jersey Mike's and propel water. That's the secret sauce. That's what I'm doing."

Q. Was this one of those matches where you had to rely on your experience?

Scott Harvey: "We talked about everything (with Jenkins his caddie), and just a lot of strategy. And he's a great player (Foley), very solid. And nobody was going to give it away. It was going to be like something, who's going to take it kind of thing. And, you know, I'm pretty fortunate."

Note – Harvey is playing in his 15th U.S. Mid-Amateur and is now tied for eighth in career match-play victories with a 27-12 record. He won the championship in 2014 and runner-up in 2016.
