**Q. Two solid rounds at both courses, what would you say were the strongest parts of your games the last two days?**

**Cody:** "It's not easy out there. Thankfully the greens were softer playing earlier in the day, made a big difference. Yesterday afternoon, it was spicy out there with the wind."

**Q: As a local resident, how many times have you played out here (At Desert Mountain)?**

**Cody:** "First time on this course (Outlaw) and third time on the other one (Cochise)."

**Q: You both played the mid-am last year in Arizona at Troon Country Club, is it a little different as a team this time around?**

**Cody:** "It's definitely different, I played not great today, I kind of rode the coat tails the last two days. That's the biggest difference."

**Q: It has to be a cool feeling, two years in a row, playing in your backyard in USGA events?**

**Cody:** "Absolutely, I have a big advantage because the ball goes farther here than anywhere else. We're at 3,000 feet and it gets warm. When it gets warm, you're used to it. Guys coming from the northern U.S. it's a struggle for them a lot of the time."

**Cody:** "He comes out and plays out here but it's always an adjustment for him (Bobby) to get his numbers."

**Bobby:** "I probably come out once or twice a year."

**Q: You both have had success in match play over the years, any changes in strategy this week compared to past?**

**Bobby:** "We're just going to get the swing dialed in and we'll be ready to go. Match play is fun; I enjoy the competitiveness of it and just getting after it."
