Q. How would you guys describe the conditions today at Outlaw?

Jeremy: “The backside is playing about as difficult as I’ve ever seen. Gusts to 30. Probably blowing 20. Pins are in those corners, we hit some amazing shots, wind would take it off the green. He (Bryan) got up and down twice to make four and were the best up and downs I’ve ever seen.”

Jeremy: “I wouldn’t say we feel old”

Bryan: “We don’t feel old. We don’t feel like we’ve given them our best yet. We left a lot out there.

Jeremy: “Only way we feel old is when they fly it by us 30 or 40.”

With your experience in USGA championships, how is it different with match play?

Jeremy: “First time match play for me.”

Bryan: “We have a little more patience now. We hit a lot of three-quarter shots. Back in the day we had a lot of is it eight is it nine and we grab the nine and wind up. A lot of times now we’re just doing what we need to do.”
