Travel Hwy. 705, Pottery Highway, in Moore county and journey into the world of American Pottery, namely Busbee Road. No poppy fields on the way. Discover the history of the art, the early functionality of the work, and meet current artisans that maintain the legacy in pieces that grace museums, appear in Hollywood productions, and can become a part of your home décor. Talk with the potters and perhaps create your own piece during your visit.

Byways – By Saddle, by Canoe, by Cycle and by Foot – Don't need no Flying Monkeys Here

The Southern Pines area is horse country, no doubt about it. If you have a horse, trailer down to the Moss Foundation and enjoy 4,000 acres of public riding trails. If you enjoy being an equestrian spectator, the Pinehurst Harness Track and the Carolina Horsepark host almost year-round events. The Pinehurst Harness Track is also the winter home of many standardbred race horses. Enjoy watching them go through their paces in the early morning. Polo, dressage, jumpers, and matinee races are just a few of the events.

Robbins is home to Bear Creek. Bring your canoe or kayak and enjoy a peaceful trip in a natural setting not too far away from the big city. Enjoy a picnic in the park. A disc golf course is available if you're so inclined.

With rolling hills, walking trails, horticultural gardens and more, the Sandhills area provides plenty of activities for miles of fun whether you are cycling, hiking, birding, or meandering through shops.
